

ARTICLE TEN

ELECTION OF OFFICERS

SECTION 1

All officers of this lodge shall be elected by printed secret ballot at a December Annual meeting of each year.

SECTION 2

The President shall designate the time and place for said ballots to be cast.

SECTION 3

No candidate for office shall solicit votes or campaign in any way that would interfere with the election process on Election Day at or near the designated balloting place.

SECTION 4

The candidate receiving the highest number of votes cast shall be declared elected.

In case of a tie between candidates having the highest number of votes in one office, a runoff election shall be held within ten (10) days.

SECTION 5

All officers of this Lodge shall be elected annually, except for the Trustees who shall serve for a period of three (3) years and one (1) Trustee shall be elected each year.
